AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI OF CHAPTER 23 CONCERNING PARADES, PROCESSIONS AND FESTIVALS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: Article VI of Chapter 23 is hereby retitled "Parades, Processions and Festivals."

Section Two: Section 23-386 is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE VI. PARADES, PROCESSIONS, AND FESTIVALS

Sec. 23-386. Permit required

(a) It shall be unlawful to conduct any parade, procession or festival upon the portion of public right of way used for vehicular travel, and for any person to participate in any parade, procession or festival, except in accordance with a permit issued by the chief of police; provided, the military forces of the United States and the state, the personnel of the police and fire departments of the city and funeral processions shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.

(b) An application for a permit to conduct a parade, procession or festival shall be made to the chief of police of the city at least thirty days prior to the conducting of the same. The application shall contain the name and address of the applicant, the time, date and route or location of the proposed parade, procession or festival and a description of any special equipment or vehicles to be used. If the information set forth on the application shall meet the requirements of this section, the chief of police shall issue a permit for the parade or procession or festival; provided, no such permit shall be issued if the nature or conduct of any parade or procession might tend to be dangerous or harmful to the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the city.

(c) In order to be eligible for a permit hereunder for any event that will occupy the portion of public right of way reserved for vehicular travel, the applicant shall provide proof of public liability insurance for the proposed event in the amount of at least one million dollars combined single limit. Such insurance must name the City as an additional insured by endorsement and must be non-cancellable without written notice to the City at least seven days before the cancellation date. Any cancellation of coverage shall cause a cancellation of the permit. The requirements for

insurance shall not apply to any permit issued to a neighborhood association within an area zoned for residential uses for purposes of a street closure for a gathering of members of the association, or residents of the area of the street closure.

Section Three: It is intended that the provisions of Section One and Two of this ordinance shall be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warrensburg.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
