**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WARRENSBURG, MISSOURI,
ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE FIRE SERVICE AND ESTABLISHING
POLICIES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FEE SCHEDULE.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG, MISSOURI, AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Copies of official fire department documents will be supplied at a rate of \$5.00 for copies up to (7) pages. Any additional pages will be at a rate of \$0.20 per page.

Section 2. The fire department is authorized to recover mitigation costs for hazardous substances in accordance with Missouri Revised Statutes Chapter 260, Sections 260.500 through 260.552. The following rates shall apply:

Engine	\$150.00
Ladder	\$200.00
Utility	\$50.00
Command Vehicle	\$100.00
Personnel	\$25.00
Disposable supplies	\$ Actual Cost
Mitigating foam	\$ Actual Cost

Additional supplies and equipment necessary to mitigate the hazardous situation.

Section 3. The following policies will be observed in the implementation and establishment of fees to provide commercial instruction and education.

1. The Fire Chief may establish fees for specific instructional or educational programs by the fire department to cover costs incurred by the department for development, delivery, and maintenance of such programs.
2. The Fire Chief may waive fees in exchange for services provided by the recipient.

Section 4. The property owner of an address where a nuisance alarm as defined in the International Fire Code as adopted by Warrensburg Code of Ordinances Chapter 10, will be charged a fee of \$75.00 per alarm after three (3) such nuisance alarms occur at the same address in the same calendar year.

Section 5. Service Calls will be charged at a rate of \$150.00/hr.

Section 6. The following definitions will apply in this resolution:

1. Nuisance Alarm – An alarm caused by mechanical failure, malfunction, improper installation or lack of proper maintenance, or an alarm activated by a cause that cannot be identified.
2. Service Call – Calls for service outside the normal fire/rescue services.

Section 7. The Fire Chief, upon approval of the City Manager is authorized to assess charges for fire services, when special circumstances warrant based upon actual cost. The special circumstance will be documented in the billing statement.
