

**Open Burning**


The Warrensburg Fire Department cannot issue a Permit for Open Burning in the City Limits of Warrensburg without an Open Burning Permit from DNR with the following exceptions;

1. Household yard wastes originating on premises from 4 dwelling units or less, burned on the same premises. (Clearing brush, trees, etc. as part of new construction or for demolition do not fall in this exclusion.)
2. Bonfire, Recreational Fires and other permitted activities as authorized by letter/permit from the Warrensburg Fire Department, in compliance with current codes, that do not require permits from DNR.

"Burn Barrels" are only allowed at locations where other types of open burning would be permitted. "Burn Barrels" are not permitted at construction sites. Natural vegetation is the only material allowed to be burned.
