



CITY OF WARRENSBURG **DEMOLITION PERMIT** **SEWER DISCONNECT / DISPOSAL NOTICE**

SANITARY SEWER SERVICE CONNECTION MUST BE CAPPED AT THE PROPERTY LINE WITH CONCRETE. A SEPARATE INSPECTION IS REQUIRED BEFORE THE DEMOLITION OF THE STRUCTURE IS STARTED!

A STOP WORK ORDER WILL BE ISSUED IF THE DEMO IS STARTED WITHOUT THE “SEWER CAP INSPECTION”.

DISPOSAL OF DEMOLITION RUBBLE

State of Missouri Department of Natural Resources advises that Section 260.210.7 RSMo, 1986, Supp. 1990, applies to jurisdictions that issue building and demolition permits.

“Notice: The disposal of demolition waste is regulated by the Department of Natural Resources under Chapter 260, RSMo. Such waste, in types and quantities established by the department, shall be taken to a demolition landfill or a sanitary landfill for disposal.”

The law, Section 260.210.6 RSMo, 1986 Supp. 1990, also requires persons engaged in building construction, modification, or demolition to maintain **RECORDS** of sites used for disposal. These records are to be maintained by the contractors for a period of one (1) year and available upon request to Missouri Department of Natural Resources personnel.

Additionally, Senate Bill 530 further provides in Section 260.211.8 and Section 260.212.8 for county and city prosecution of illegal dumping in violation of Section 260.210.

The City of Warrensburg hereby notifies you of the above law. The City asks your compliance. If non-compliance is discovered, then prosecution will follow.
