DREAM Reps to Begin Land Use, Building & Infrastructure Survey in Downtown

Warrensburg, Missouri – A land use, building and infrastructure survey has been initiated by professional planners from PGAV Urban Consulting, the state's consultant for the DREAM Initiative. The survey is part of the ongoing information gathering the Downtown Revitalization and Economic Assistance for Missouri (DREAM) Initiative.

Warrensburg was one of 10 communities chosen in 2008 for this innovative program.

The Land Use, Building & Infrastructure Survey inventories the Warrensburg Study Area's existing land use, exterior building conditions, and the conditions of public infrastructure. "This is first step and provides a foundation for the development of a comprehensive revitalization plan for Warrensburg Downtown," said Bob Miserez, Executive Director of the Missouri Development Finance Board. "Once the planning phase is complete, we all look forward to moving to the implementation phase."

The DREAM Initiative helps small and mid-sized Missouri communities access existing State assistance programs to help with downtown revitalization and job creation efforts. The DREAM Initiative allows communities to more efficiently and effectively engage in downtown redevelopment and revitalization as well as attract new private investment into the heart of their communities.
