The meeting was called to order at 5:01pm. Quorum was established.

Roll Call:

Voting Members Present: Sarah Chamberlin, Steve Carter, Allison Robbins, Sue Kraus

Voting Members Absent: Cindy Bechtol, Hannah Clark

Ex-Officio Present: Marcella McCoy, Eddie Osborne

Approval of Agenda: Sue motioned to approve, and Steve seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes: Sarah motioned to approve, and Sue seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

No **guests or visitors** were present.

Updates:

Marcella noted that the City continued to work on the budget for the next fiscal year.

Allison and Sue briefly described their attendance at MACAA on the Spot on May 5th, which was held in Lexington, Missouri.

New Business:

The Commission discussed and finalized the Art Commission Budget Request for FY24. The Commission budgeted \$9,000 in expenses, and \$7,500 in projected revenue. The projected shortfall of \$1,500 will come from the cash reserve. Steve motioned to approve the budget request, Sue seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Marcella updated the budget worksheet and entered detail for each line item.

The commission briefly discussed a coloring page for distribution at Old Drum day. Sarah indicated she would complete the coloring page before June 12.

Old Business:

Allison shared updates on the Community Theater Fundraiser, now planned for the end of October. The Commission agreed to partner with the Community Center for the event, per a conversation with director Chris Deal. The dates will likely be the weekend of October 26 to October 29. Sue noted that the ABC

Building will be unavailable that weekend due to the woodcarving seminar with Roger Stegall. Sarah requested that Cindy send any information about advertising and promotion that might have come with the Carol Burnett script purchase.

Eddie described how the Historical Society was planning to bring in storytellers for an upcoming event.

The **next meeting** will take place on June 12, given that June 19 is the Juneteenth holiday. Agenda items for June will include the City Photo Contest.

The meeting was **adjourned** at 5:50pm.
