WHEREAS, we value what is important to people with disabilities and their families who are striving for everyday lives no different than those of all other citizens; and

WHEREAS, disability should not hinder the right of people to make choices, contribute to and be part of their community, and to make efforts to create their perfect life; and

Whereas, family members, friends, and the community all play a vital role in enhancing the lives of people with disabilities as they realize their full potential; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the City of Warrensburg include opportunities for people with disabilities to achieve their full potential through employment, recreation, and housing. These goals support the development of meaningful and productive lives.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bryan Jacobs, Mayor of the City of Warrensburg, Missouri, along with the other members of the City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of March as:

NATIONAL DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AWARENESS MONTH

in the City of Warrensburg. I call upon the citizens of Warrensburg to observe the month with programs and activities that celebrate our diverse range of abilities, skills, and potential. Furthermore, I encourage the citizens of Warrensburg to grow their understanding of how they can support inclusion for people with disabilities by collaborating with organizations that have expertise in matters concerning disabilities.
