SUBJECT: An Ordinance Establishing a Stop Sign on Northbound Maple Street at Oak Street, in the City of Warrensburg, Missouri.

BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Commission met March 17th and heard concerns from members of the community regarding the intersection of Maple and Oak. The intersection is a 'T' intersection with Maple Street coming to a 'T' at Oak Street. There is not a stop sign or other traffic control for any direction of traffic. There is a pole that indicates there may have been a stop sign for Northbound Maple at Oak, however, there is not a sign. A review of city ordinances did not reveal an ordinance authorizing a stop sign at this intersection. The Traffic Commission voted unanimously to place a stop sign at the intersection.

ISSUE:

Consideration of placing a stop sign on Northbound Maple Street at Oak Street.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of installation is estimated at \$100 from the Street Maintenance Signage budget.

ECONOMIC BENEFITS/IMPACT:

Improvement to traffic safety at the intersection reducing the potential for future property damage or injury.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of the ordinance as written.
