PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS National Preservation Month is a way to promote historic places for the purpose of instilling national and community pride, promoting heritage tourism, and showing the social and economic benefits of historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, since 2008, the Historic Preservation Commission has completed a Cultural Resource Survey, Multiple Property Documentation Form, and listing of the Grover Street Victorian Historic District and Holden and Pine Streets Commercial Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, Warrensburg is home to two local landmarks, the Colonel Roberts House and Phillips Gross Brewery Cave; and

WHEREAS the Historic Preservation Commission partners with Warrensburg Main Street to conduct the annual Historic Stroll of downtown Warrensburg; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission continues to conduct ongoing research to identify historic properties which have historic, community, or architectural value through the Grover and Broad Streets Architectural & Historical Survey.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Scott Holmberg, Mayor of Warrensburg, Missouri, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2021 **NATIONAL PRESERVATION MONTH** in Warrensburg, Missouri, and call upon the residents of Warrensburg to join their fellow citizens across the United States in celebrating the historic resources within our own community and increasing public awareness of the importance of historic preservation.
