The following items were discussed/acted upon at the March 17th, 2021 Traffic Commission Meeting:

- A. Meeting was called to order at 4:03 P.M. by Dewayne Jackson
- B. Members in attendance: Dwayne Jackson, Danielle Dulin, Jim Kushner, Carl Staas, Andrew Munsterman, and Bill Brinkley. Monda Reynolds was absent. Visitors: None
- C. The minutes from the September 15th, 2021 meeting were accepted as presented. (Carl made a motion, Danielle Second, Motion passed)
- D. Discussion of pedestrian crossing issues. The 50 highway (Maguire) bridge will address issues there. WPD to observe pedestrian crossings at the north round-a-bout.
- E. Commission voted to approve the already installed street signs in the new subdivision (Pines at Hale Lake). (Carl made motion, seconded by Danielle, all attending members voted to approve)
- F. Further discussion was had in reference to changes to be made to the operation of the Traffic Commission. Members approved a motion (Danielle, second by Staas) to table the issue until Danielle could do further research into changing the ordinance, or whether the current ordinance would allow for practice changes.
