



WARRENSBURG COMMUNITY CENTER (WCC) CODE OF CONDUCT RULES

General Community Center Building and Community Center Grounds Rules:

- A. The Warrensburg Community Center (WCC) building and grounds are controlled-access facilities under the direction of Warrensburg Parks & Recreation (WPR).
- B. All patrons must check-in at Front Desk and wear the appropriate wristband to use the Gymnasium, Aquatic Center, Track and/or Fitness Center.
- C. Youth aged 10 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (age 18+) within the WCC at all times unless participating in a WPR program/activity.
- D. Youth 11 – 17 years old entering the facility unaccompanied by an adult (age 18+), unless participating in a WPR program/activity, **MUST** have a WPR Account with photo, current address, phone number and a WCC Youth Account Contract signed by youth and guardian and on file before using the facility.
- E. Demonstrate respect for yourself, other patrons, staff, and property while enjoying the facility.
- F. Screaming, yelling, excessive noises, abusive or foul language and being disrespectful is strictly prohibited. These actions may result in immediate expulsion from the building and grounds and/or loss of future privileges.
- G. Anyone using physical force towards another patron or employee will be suspended for a minimum of one year.
- H. No roughhousing or horseplay or running in hallways.
- I. No smoking or tobacco products allowed in the center.
- J. Food and beverages are permitted in lobby, community rooms, party rooms and meeting rooms. Gum is prohibited. Glass containers are prohibited. Food is not permitted in the Fitness Center, Pool, or Gym; all trash must be disposed of properly.
- K. Picture/Video taking is not allowed in locker rooms or restrooms.
- L. Personal music devices are only allowed when used with headphones, unless approved by WPR Staff for private rental or WPR program.
- M. All weapons are prohibited. Violators will be asked to leave, and, under appropriate circumstances, banned from the facility.
- N. Illegal drugs and alcoholic beverages are prohibited. Anyone caught with illegal drugs (including prescription drugs without prescription) will be turned over to the police and permanently banned from the building.
- O. Shirt, shorts, pants, and shoes or flipflops are required in the Center except in the Pool Area and Locker Rooms.

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- P. Bicycles, skateboards and in-line skates are prohibited. Animals in the facility are restricted to service dogs only.
- Q. Warrensburg Parks & Recreation (WPR) is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lockers are provided, please bring your own lock, or buy one at the Front Desk. Locks must be removed daily.
- R. Anyone caught stealing will be reported to the police.

Front Lobby/Hallways Rules:

- A. No sleeping, jumping, or laying down on equipment, furniture, or floor.
- S. Keep noise to a minimum; excessive noise is not allowed. Personal music devices are only allowed when used with headphones.
- B. Phone may be used for local calls only (2-minute limit).
- C. Horseplay is not permitted, which includes running.
- D. Bouncing balls in the hallway or lobby may result in expulsion from the facility.

Fitness Center Rules:

- A. All users of the equipment must have purchased a current daily pass, 10 punch pass, monthly all-access membership, or annual all-access membership. Users must check in at the WCC Front Desk to obtain a WCC wristband.
- B. Children aged 15 & under are NOT allowed in the Fitness area.
- C. Patrons aged 16-17 with a pass (and Youth Contract on file) are allowed to use fitness equipment appropriately without adult supervision.
- D. Shirts, shorts, or pants (no jeans) and shoes are required. No open-toed or open-backed shoes, boots, or sandals are allowed. No barefoot training allowed.
- E. If someone is waiting to use a particular piece of equipment, please limit your workout to 30 minutes.
- F. Only water-based drinks with a lid allowed. Absolutely NO OTHER DRINKS OR FOOD.
- G. To maintain equipment: do not drop weights, lower weight stacks carefully, return dumbbells and weight plates to racks when finished and report any problems to WPR staff. Please clean equipment when finished. Spray cleaner onto towel, not directly onto equipment.
- H. Personal Training is only allowed by Certified WPR Staff Members.

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Track Rules:

- A. Children ages 15 and under must be accompanied/supervised by an adult.
- B. No spitting on the track.
- C. Only water with a lid allowed. Absolutely NO OTHER DRINKS OR FOOD.
- D. Runners on outside of track, walkers on the inside.
- E. No horseplay on the track.
- F. Strollers are allowed on the track.
- G. No standing or spectators on the track.

Gymnasium Rules:

- A. Food is not permitted in the gymnasium, unless approved by WPR Staff for a party or rental.
- B. Drinks with a screw top lid are permitted; if a spill occurs, please locate the nearest WPR staff member to have it cleaned immediately.
- C. NO DUNKING, GRASPING, OR HANGING ON RIMS/OR NETS.
- D. Personal music devices are only allowed when used with headphones, unless approved by WPR Staff for private rental or WPR program.
- E. Appropriate shoes are required (closed-toe athletic shoes).
- F. Side to side and full court pickup games will only be allowed with less than 20 people in the gym and approval from WPR Staff. Time limit may be enforced at the discretion of WPR Staff.
- G. No spitting on the floor.
- H. Youth aged 10 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (age 18+) within the WCC at all times unless participating in a WPR program/activity.

Indoor Aquatic Center Rules:

- A. No running.
- B. No diving (feet first entries only). With the exception the diving blocks for competitive teams.
- C. Only water with a lid allowed. Absolutely NO OTHER DRINKS OR FOOD.
- D. No denim or cut-offs (swim attire must be worn).
- E. Diapers are not allowed; Swim diapers must be worn by all not potty trained.
- F. No flotation devices on slide(s).
- G. Private swim lessons may only be taught by WPR Aquatic Staff.
- H. All users of the pool must have a WCC wristband. Observers may use the benches without a wristband.

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Indoor Aquatic Center Slide Rules:

- A. Participants need to be a minimum of 48 inches or taller to go down the slide.
- B. Only one person allowed on the slide at a time.
- C. Participants must line up on the stairs in a single file line.
- D. Do not stop, kneel, or rotate on the slide. Keep arms and hands inside the flume at all times.
- E. Sliders must go down the slide feet first, lying on their back, or in a sitting position.
- F. Sliders may NOT be caught by another person, or the lifeguard, in the catch pool.
- G. Before another person may go down the slide, he/she must wait for the lifeguard's signal.
- H. NO goggles, fins, glasses, metal watches, swimming suits with metal zippers, buckles, rivets, buttons, or ornamentation allowed on the slide.
- I. NO lifejackets, water wings, or any flotation devices are allowed on the slide.
- J. Swimmers must exit the catch pool quickly.
- K. Obey lifeguards at all times.
- L. Patrons who are pregnant, have a fear of heights, or have experienced heart or back problems should NOT use the slide.

Indoor Aquatic Center Spa Rules:

- A. Spa hours will follow the main indoor pool schedule but may close at times for maintenance.
- B. Adults aged 16 and older only.
- C. No more than 10 people are permitted in the spa at one time.
- D. Do not use while under the influence of anticoagulants, antihistamines, vasoconstrictors, stimulants, hypnotics, narcotics, tranquilizers, or alcohol.
- E. Individuals suffering from heart disease, diabetes, high/low blood pressure, and expectant mothers should not use the hot tub.
- F. Showers are required by all participants prior to use.
- G. Hair longer than shoulder length must be pulled back.
- H. Additional rules and stipulations may be enforced at any time as a safety concern.

Failure to comply with any Warrensburg Parks & Recreation (WPR) rules may result in suspension and/or permanent ejection, at the sole discretion of WPR Staff.

WPR reserves the right to change rules at any time.

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
