


A RECOMMENDED WAY TO SHOVEL YOUR DRIVEWAY

By shoveling according to the diagram below, you reduce the possibility of getting a huge pile of snow in your driveway opening when snow plow trucks clear your street:

Make snow collection pocket - Standing in the street looking at your house, clear an area approximately ten (10) feet to the right of your driveway. Clearing this area provides an area for the snow on the plow blade to unload before it gets to your driveway.

Shovel in direction of travel - Standing in the street looking at your house, the area to the left of your drive is the ideal place to pile the shoveled snow from the end of your driveway. Be a good neighbor and keep your pile from being deflected into your neighbor's drive downstream of the plow.
